Street Parking Ban

The City Ordinance banning parking on the unpaved section of your yard and on the street is enforced by our Police. The following procedure is used before issuing a ticket. Once the patrol begins the Officer observes all illegally parked vehicles. If the vehicle is still illegally parked after he has patrolled for one hour, he issues the ticket. If you have never received one before the ticket will be a warning only. If you receive a ticket you want to contest, you should request a hearing before the CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD. If the board agrees with you, the fine will be adjusted. IF the board agrees with the Officer, the fine is increased from \$25 to \$75. You will then have 14 days to pay the fine. After 14 days, each day thereafter will be considered a new fine of \$75. The City is authorized to place a lien against your vehicle or other property at any time: thereafter, the lien will not exceed \$3,000.
